
- We all being from the same background and similar financial conditions had inner drive to put efforts for poor and meritorious students and bear their educational needs, named it as AASARA...















ORGANOGRAM






FINANCIAL STATUS




- Knowing the importance of education, Team Abhayam initiated AASARA program in 2009.

RECENT ACTIVITIES
